### Travel by public transport

- You can get to Glenshieling House by bus.
- All buses terminate in Blairgowrie Town Centre. The bus stop is 1 miles / 1.6 km from Glenshieling House.
- Glenshieling House is situated approximately one mile from the centre of Blairgowrie. When travelling from the South, at the traffic lights in the town centre follow the signs for the A93 to Braemar. Continue over the bridge - take left turn into Balmoral Road (A93 to Glenshee/Braemar). Proceed for 0.75 miles and turn right into Bonnington Road, at crossroads turn right, Glenshieling House is situated approximately 200 yards on the right.



### Travel by taxi

- You can get a taxi with Lynda's Lifts by calling 01828 640867. The taxi company has a wheelchair accessible vehicle.
- You can get a taxi with A&B Taxis by calling 01738 634567. The taxi company has a wheelchair accessible vehicle.
- We have a transfer service for visitors. By prior arrangement only. We can arrange car pick-up and / or drop off from main bus terminus in Blairgowrie to Glenshieling House



### Parking

- We have a car park. The parking is less than 50 metres from the main entrance. Parking is free.
- There is a drop-off point at the main entrance. The drop-off point does not have a dropped kerb.
- From the parking to the main entrance, there are 2 steps. There is no ramp and no lift.
- It is a gravel carpark to the rear of house. The main entrance to the house has 2 steps.

## Arrival

### Path to main entrance

- From the street to the main entrance, there is level access.
- The path is sloped.

### Main entrance

- The door is 860mm wide.
- The main entrance has 2 steps.
- The other entrance door is 740mm wide.
- Adjacent to carpark at rear of house.

## Getting around inside

### Bedrooms

- All bedrooms have windows.
- Bedrooms have ceiling lights, wall lights, floor standing lights, bedside lamps and desk or table lamps.
- Lights are LED and energy saving. TVs have subtitles.
- All bedrooms are non-smoking.
- We have non-allergic bedding.
- All bedrooms have fitted carpets.
- We can give details of our cleaning products on request. PLEASE NOTE WE HAVE OUR OWN PET DOG THAT HAS ACCESS TO PUBLIC ROOMS DOWNSTAIRS.
- No bedrooms have level access. The bedroom nearest the main entrance has 22 steps.
- All bedrooms are ensuite.
- We have bathrooms with a separate shower.

## Place to eat and drink

### Breakfast room

- From the main entrance to the dining area, there are 2 steps. There is no lift and no ramp.
- To get to a table, there are no steps.
- The menu is offered in large print.
- If you need table service, staff can help you.
- There is background music sometimes.
- We cater for sugar free (diabetic), vegetarian, gluten free (celiacs), lactose free (dairy free), low fat and vegan specific diets.
- We are happy to provide large print guest information and menus on request.

### Guest Lounge / Bar area

- From the main entrance to this area, there are 2 steps. There is no lift and no ramp.
- Smallest entrance is from lounge to bar area is 740mm

## Getting around outside

### Garden seating area and outdoor smoking area

- From the main entrance to the area, there are 2 steps.
- Access from front entrance down 2 steps across gravel driveway directly onto gently sloping lawn area.

Main entrance has a gravel pathway leading directly onto gently sloping lawn.

## Customer care support

### Accessibility equipment

- Large print guest information and menus on request.

- We have an area to charge mobility scooters and battery powered wheelchairs.
- On request we can charge collapsible scooter / electric chairs. This may benefit guests that require mobile aids when outdoors but are able to manage without assistance indoors.
